### Monday - Rāhina

**TERM 2 DATES: Mon 28 April – Fri 27 June 2025**

<b>10am–12pm</b>	<b>1 - Poetry Writing &amp; Performance</b>	A place to read your writing aloud. Diverse, weekly exercises & tailored feedback provided.
<b>9am-12pm</b>	<b>2 - Painting Now (By invitation)</b>	This is an intermediate to advanced painting class designed to encourage you to develop your own practice and research.
<b>1pm–3pm</b>	<b>3 - Toi Hono</b>	Exploration of Māori Art & Culture in a safe and fun space.
<b>1pm-2pm</b>	<b>4 - Acoustic Guitar &amp; Music</b>	Introduction to learning basic guitar chords and playing, as well as to develop your singing and music skills.
<b>2pm–4pm</b>	<b>5 - Singing &amp; Music</b>	Come sing for the joy of it! Learn simple techniques, experience uplifting songs and fun classes.
<b>5pm-7pm</b>	<b>6 - Screen Printing</b>	Students will learn the ancient art of silk-screen printing on textiles. This class will teach you how to turn a drawing or idea into a material design that can be printed with textile ink on clothing or fabric.

### Tuesday - Rātū

<b>10.30am-12.30pm</b>	<b>7 - Paint the Sky</b>	Explore your artistic ideas in a supportive environment. This is a beginner's class, focussed on drawing and painting.
<b>1pm-3pm</b>	<b>8 - Performance &amp; Acting</b>	Screen and theatre acting, theatre sports, script & character analysis, workshops, and public speaking.
<b>1 pm-3pm</b>	<b>9 - Draw &amp; Paint with a Twist</b>	Intermediate class for those looking to extend their drawing and painting skills. Practice with different media and techniques.

### Wednesday - Rāapa

<b>9.30-10.30am</b>	<b>10 - Movement &amp; Dance</b>	Explore movements and dance in a gentle and fun way.
<b>10.30am-12.30pm</b>	<b>11 – Mosaic Workshop</b>	Have fun creating your own mosaic with coloured glass and ceramic tile. Basic colour and design ideas are included. All work is grouted.
<b>1pm-4pm</b>	<b>12 - Printmaking</b>	Develop your own designs and images by exploring a range of techniques, such as wood and lino cuts, etching and monoprints.
<b>1.30pm-3.30pm</b>	<b>13 - Building Blocks for Better Photography</b>	Gain foundational knowledge of digital photography, and Adobe Lightroom Classic. All skill levels welcome.

<b>10am-12pm</b>	<b>14 - Face &amp; Figure Drawing</b>	Draw a clothed, live model where possible. Develop your style & technique. Learn about the human form through renowned artists.
<b>10am-12pm</b>	<b>15 – Multimedia</b>	Learn a range of software for editing videos and photos for social media, desktop publishing and web design. Help with entire Creative Cloud.
<b>1pm- 4pm</b>	<b>16 - Music Recording</b>	Record your own music with the support of an experienced engineer.
<b>1pm–3pm</b>	<b>17 – Painting</b>	Introduction to a variety of painters and exploring your own style.
<b>4pm – 5pm</b>	<b>18 - Movement &amp; Dance</b>	Explore movements and dance in a gentle and fun way.
